Cancellation Policy: All registration fees and class fees are non-refundable. Railway Operations Live is an interactive two-and-a-half day course that offers a glimpse into “a day in the life of a railway crew member.” This introductory program on Canadian railway operations is designed and delivered by the Railway Association of Canada in collaboration with industry experts.

The course covers a range of topics: safety standards, the Canadian Rail Operating Rules (CROR), railcar design, train make-up and inspections, locomotive operation, and switching demonstrations. It also gives a basic introduction to track inspection and maintenance, including the reporting of potential defects. Participants will have the opportunity to safely switch cars and build a train in a real railway environment as part of this hands-on training experience.

Course instructors are North American railway experts and draw upon their years of experience to offer participants an informative view of the industry.
